- **The grant of an immigration pass to you will be determined by the Immigration & Checkpoints Authority (ICA) officers at the point of entry.** From 11 March 2022, all foreign visitors arriving in Singapore will be notified digitally of their Visit Pass (e-Pass) through email. There will not be any endorsement on their passports. The e-Pass notification will indicate the period of stay granted and last day of stay allowed. Please ensure that they provide a valid email address when submitting the SG Arrival Card.
- **Travellers must submit their arrival information, including their health declaration, using the SG Arrival Card e-Service** (<https://eservices.ica.gov.sg/sgarrivalcard>), up to three (3) days before their entry into Singapore.
